Keep on Reading – Year 4

Keep on Reading is a project which promotes reading and allows families to continue to read together and encounter books and authors perhaps not previously met. The project began at this school in 2005 and is now taking place in over thirty other Essex and Southend schools. This project involves asking all the parents of children in a class to read the same book to their child.

We would like you to:

- Read the book to your child that they have brought home in the plastic wallet in a number of instalments suitable to you and your child. Please do not ask the child to read to you.
- Finish the book by **Thursday 7th November 2019** and then return the book to school.
- In the wallet is a laminated card with some questions and discussion points you might like to talk to your child about in relation to the story. Please do not ask your child to write or draw anything in connection with the book.

Les Kemp, the Keep on Reading Project Director, will be in school on **Thursday 7th November and Friday 8th November 2019** to talk to the class about the book. Within this session all the children will be given a badge and will be asked to share their opinion of the book.

Last year we had to replace many Keep on Reading books which were not returned to us. All books are signed out to the children and if they are not returned a charge of £5 will be made to cover the cost of replacing the book.

I hope this book will appeal to you as much as to your child. If the above request presents any difficulties please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.
