Year 4 Ipswich Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Egyptians topic next term we will be visiting the Ipswich Museum in order to learn more about the Ancient Civilisation.

We will have educational sessions run by the members of staff at the museum where pupils will have the opportunity to handle real Ancient Egyptian objects to discover the stories they have to tell, create timelines, make clay shabtis for the Pharaoh, explore the Natural History gallery and discover the animals that inspired the Gods of Ancient Egypt. As well as a few other things!

The dates for the trip are:

Tuesday 10 th March 2020	4 Kemp and 4 White
Thursday 12 th March 2020	4 Pettet and 4 Sturgeon
Friday 13 th March 2020	4 King and 4 Hughes

We will be travelling by coach and will be leaving school promptly at 9.00 am and arriving back in time for the end of school. Children should wear their usual school uniform and normal school shoes. If your child suffers from asthma, please ensure they have their asthma pump in their bag for the trip. All children will need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals one will be provided.

The cost of the trip to Ipswich Museum is £12.95. Consent and payment is required by **Monday 2nd March**. We encourage all payments to be made via the online payment system but should this not be possible then payment can be made by cheque which should be payable to Moulsham Junior School and placed in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and 'Ipswich Museum Year 4 Trip March.' You will also be able to confirm consent for your child to take part in this trip via the online payment system. Unfortunately no child is able to attend without this consent. If you require any help with our online system please contact a member of the office staff.

In line with Government regulations, payment can only be asked for as a voluntary donation. However, we must stress that if enough donations are not received then this trip may have to be cancelled as the school has no specific funding for activities of this nature.

On this occasion we will not be visiting the gift shop so there is no need for children to bring in spending money.
