One star answer

Three star answer

1. This should be 4.38 as it takes an hour (12 x 5= 60 minutes)
2. 1 hour 26 minutes
3. 46 minutes a day, school is 5 days so $46 \times 5 = 230$ minutes so 3 hours and 50 mins
